1.a	INVITE TO HEAD OF SECURITY HMP ONLEY	Keith Cummings accepted invite	
1.b	CHAIR ATRTED OFF MEETING	<p>Keith introduces himself and advised why the leaflet had been distributed to all residents at Onley estate he also advised he has been head of security for around two years. Onley experiencing big issues with drones flying drugs into the establishment. Test have been carried out as far a M45 where it is possible to fly to Onley with a drone. Regular meetings are now held between HMP Onley, Rye Hill and MTCNOVA due to the added security risks. Three ways drugs can be brought in a) Visitors, b) Staff or c) across the fence. A & B are dealt with but C is a problem, this includes people on foot throwing drugs over or drones.</p> <p>Chair enquired about gypsies and how the establishment would deal with the possibility of gypsies arriving on site to Onley. Reason for asking this question is because odd men have been seen on the estate road just off prison drive taking an interest in this field.</p> <p>Chairman mentioned problems with boundary fence near old service road missing two panels, Meadow to left as you enter estate requires grass cutting, old service road requires trees cutting back and on top of this balancing pond requires dense foliage to be cleared. It was confirmed balancing pond responsibility of Rye Hill. Group4.</p> <p>Secretary informed Keith she had written to the governor of Onley twice concerning the fence</p>	

		<p>panels blown down and was informed by the governor he would pass it on to Amey who now hold the contract for HMP Onley but nothing has been done to date. This could potentially be a security breach for the prison when outside people wish to escape after dropping off drugs to make a quick getaway from Onley Staff. Lottie confirmed this was already happening, she is ware drug people are leaving from Onley estate.</p> <p>Keith advised he could mention the issues at the next meeting he has with each establishment.</p> <p>Chair advised he would ensure a newsletter to the estate and include the Barby and Onley website which would raise awareness and advise any suspicious sittings to the number provided.</p> <p>Enquiry was made about the two cameras that has been mounted on the lamp post to the right as you leave Onley prison drive. Keith informed us they should belong to Warwickshire police.</p> <p>The APR camera on prison drive belongs to Northampton police.</p> <p>Keith was advised he was welcome to stay for remaining meeting but chose to leave as he was on his own time and had covered everything required.</p>
