3.4	COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORT – No report received. A briefing Meeting to explain the changes to a Unitary Authority is being held in Wellingborough on Thursday 12 th July 2 – 4m at the Castle Theatre.

5	TO APPROVE AND SIGN MINUTES	
5.1	It was resolved to approve and sign the Minutes of 11 th June 2018 as a correct record.	
6	MATTERS ARISING for information only.	
6.1	It was reported that Cllr Cotton had been unable to arrange to put up “No Parking” signs at Onley Park. These will be done by Mr Camp when the ground is less hard.	
7	ENVIRONMENT	
7.1	TREE SURVEY - NCC have now confirmed that no tree works will be carried out apart from those which are a safety risk to the public highway. Tree quotes have been chased.	
7.2	It was resolved to proceed with Crown Lifting at Onley Park in the interest of Mowing safety.	
7.3	Concern was raised over leylandii planted at Holme Way/Kilsby Road junction. A letter to be sent to the owners asking them to ensure that they are kept well trimmed to prevent them reducing traffic sight lines	
7.4	Gavin Callard has been asked to advise on replacement trees for Ware Orchard.	
7.5	Councillors were asked to check whether they felt that a fence on Rectory Lane has encroached onto the highway verge.	
7.6	It was reported that the hedge at Westfield House has grown out so far across the pavement that it cannot be used by people pushing buggies. A letter to be sent to the owners asking for it to be trimmed.	
7.7	It has been reported that the Surface Water drains at the top of Elkington Lane are blocked which has resulted in flooding of adjacent houses. This has been referred to Severn Trent.

8.1	<i>New Planning Applications –</i>	
8.1.1	DA/2018/0462 Demolition of existing utility/sun room and construction of 2 storey rear extension. 56 Rugby Road, Barby. The Parish Council had no objections.	
8.1.2	DA/2018/0382 outline application for demolition of workshop and construction of 2 detached dwellings with on-site parking (revised scheme) 6 The Green, Barby. 1 x 2 bed plot; 1 x 3 bed plot. Both houses to be 1400mm from the road.	

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	Barby & Onley Parish Council has no objections to two dwellings on this site, but want the frontage of the dwellings to be in line with No 8 and 10 the Green. Since this is an outline application, the council wish to state that they would object strongly if more than two dwellings are built on this site. The dwellings must be of a maximum of 2 storey, be in keeping with the adjacent cottages, No 8 and 10, and not be further forward towards the road than No 8 and 10.

9.7	Cllr Gove gave a review of spend vs budget which is in good shape. He raised concern that the Electricity Bills did not accurately charge for usage. 10.1	It was noted that Onley Village Hall held a committee meeting on 19 th June. Minutes are on website.	
10.2	To note that Joe Oliver has agreed to arrange to trim the Willows on RHS at Onley	
11	YOUTH MATTERS	
11.1	To receive Play Area inspection reports. It was noted that there are holes in the turf at Barby, and that pieces of trim are missing from around the edging.	
11.2	Cllr Pandhal and the Clerk had met with a rep from Pentagon Play who will help bid for a £10k Awards for All grant. We have asked for a Climbing frame, rope tunnel, trapeze bars and roll-over bars.	
11.3	The Clerk was asked to obtain prices for Adult outdoor fitness equipment. Single pieces of equipment can be purchased for about £1000.	
11.4	It was resolved to get the hedge around the Play Area trimmed.	
12	HIGHWAYS	
12.1	Demand Response Transport Proposal to look at setting up a pilot to help areas with poor bus links. – Cllr Blezard reported on a meeting he attended to set up a system of small mini buses which would operate in a similar system to Uber. This to be trialled in the spring. This system would not provide a door to door service, and would not replace DACT. The Clerk was asked to write to NCC to ask what the position is with regard to D1 and D2 buses	
12.2	It was resolved that the Clerk should proceed with ordering an additional 5 street lights for the dark areas of the village of Barby up to a maximum spend of £7000. Lamps to be installed on Kilsby Road opposite the Play Area, The Green, 2 x on Pittoms Lane, and end of Kilsby Road.	
12.3	A report on Parish and Town Council Meeting 14 th June was noted.	
12.4	The Clerk had been contacted as HGVs had been diverted via Welton Rd off A361. I Boyes has investigated and there have been no authorised road closures forcing HGVs to make a diversion.	
12.5	Storm drains on Elkington Lane need clearing out. These have been referred to Severn Trent.	
12.6	Councillors were made aware of a Question and Answer session to be hosted by Chris Heaton-Harris MP, Professor Colin Corpus, and Ken Ritchie at ICON Centre on Sat 14 July at 6pm.
