

**FLAG FLYING POLICY**

Barby & Onley Parish Council own a flagpole situated on Daventry Road at the junction with "The Green", Barby.

- Flags to be flown from this flagpole will be in line with the list produced on an annual basis by the Department of Culture, Media and Sport. One flag to be flown at a time.

**Dates for flying the Union Flag on UK government buildings in 2020/Flagpoles**

- 9 January Birthday of the Duchess of Cambridge
- 20 January Birthday of the Countess of Wessex
- 6 February Her Majesty's Accession
- 19 February Birthday of the Duke of York
- 1 March St David's Day (in Wales only, see note 1)
- 9 March Commonwealth Day (second Monday in March, see note 5)
- 10 March Birthday of the Earl of Wessex
- 17 March St. Patrick's Day (in Northern Ireland only, see note 4)
- 21 April Birthday of Her Majesty the Queen
- 23 April St George's Day (in England only, see note 1)
- 2 June Coronation Day
- 10 June Birthday of the Duke of Edinburgh
- 13 June Official celebration of Her Majesty's birthday
- 21 June Birthday of the Duke of Cambridge
- **Last Saturday in JUNE Armed Forces Day**
- 17 July Birthday of the Duchess of Cornwall
- 15 August Birthday of the Princess Royal
- **15 SEPTEMBER Battle of Britain Day**
- 8 November Remembrance Day (second Sunday in November, see note 2)
- 14 November Birthday of the Prince of Wales
- 20 November Her Majesty's Wedding Day
  - Protocol for death of a Monarch, or other member of the Royal Family is to be followed in consultation with the Clerk and as set out on the Flag Flying Institute website. (This will take precedence over the above list issued by DCMS.)

Union Flag on vertical flag pole to be flown at Half mast when the Monarchs death is announce, return to full mast for proclamation @ 11am on D + 1 (where D is the Day of Death) D + 2 back to half mast. (If you don't have a union flag you can fly the St George flag.)

- Any other flags to be flown from the Flagpole must be approved by the Parish Council in advance, and must not represent any Political Party. Any flag thus approved may only be flown, if no other flag as listed above is flying.
