BARBY @ KILSBY CHURCHES' NEWS NOVEMBER 2017

As the days start to shorten, the temperature drops, and the leaves fall, we naturally enter a time of reflection. So in this month we have services for All Saints' and Remembrance Sunday; times to remember loved ones and to give thanks for the freedoms we enjoy. Barby and Kilsby Schools will also be holding Remembrance observances on Friday 10th to which everyone is welcome. (See the calendar on the back cover.)

At Christmas the Daventry Team Ministry and Daventry Deanery will be saying 'farewell' to Rev Canon Sarah Brown, Team Vicar at Braunston, Ashby St Ledgers and Welton, and Rural Dean for Daventry. News of Sarah's move has been a surprise to us all. Sarah has been appointed Canon Missioner at Peterborough Cathedral; a challenging and exciting role that I'm sure she will relish and excel in. That leaves the Team with a timely opportunity to rethink deployment

and resourcing: Population growth, particularly in Daventry, presents a challenge. Thankfully, a new Church School is being built on the Monksmoor estate. This will help us to think strategically as we consider new and creative ways of facilitating worship and pastoral care.

Last month we also said 'welcome' to Rev Canon Mary Garbutt at a service of 'Celebrating New Ministry' in Staverton church. Mary is now the Team Vicar for Staverton, Hellidon and Catesby. We're grateful that Peterborough Diocese has moved swiftly to fill that vacancy and we're optimistic that the vacancy Sarah leaves will not last too long.

At St Faith's some trees have been cleared from the Churchyard, opening up the walkway from Hall Close to Church Walk. I understand there are a few logs available. A donation towards the cost of felling would be appreciated.
