
Benefice Newsletter

One more step along the world I go... Familiar words from a song well known to many parents, and likely to be sung in schools up and down the country at the end of this term. An optimistic song, celebrating the journey through life and the benefits of moving forward with enthusiasm. Another step is taken, maybe up to the next class, and for many, to another school, or college, or university; to employment, or unemployment. A step **From the old things to the new...** a new environment; fresh faces; different tasks and challenges. Even if excited about the next step the new is likely to give a sense of trepidation. 
