## Benefice Newsletter

From Ascension Day on 30th May to Pentecost on 9th June, Christians of many denominations will be praying the central petition of the Lord's Prayer, 'Thy Kingdom come' with the hope that many will come to know Jesus the Christ as Lord of their life and the saviour of humanity; that his Kingdom of love, peace and justice may be known in the hearts of individuals and in the communities and nations of which we are a part.

'It was on the feast of Pentecost, 50 days after Jesus Christ's resurrection & 10 days following his Ascension, that the gift of the promised Holy Spirit filled the first disciples. The gathered group spilled out into the streets & public square of Jerusalem & Jesus' promise was proved true - the Holy Spirit empowered the followers of Jesus to be witnesses.' (TKC)

'Thy Kingdom come' was an initiative of the Archbishops of Canterbury and York, first celebrated in 2016. Since then its popularity and influence have grown, and now Christians and Churches everywhere are joining in with this wave of prayer. We can all simply join in, where we are, in our churches or by meeting with others.

This year 'TKC' will culminate with a Prayer Festival in Trafalgar Square. Everyone is invited (see opposite).

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place... All of them were filled with

the Holy Spirit... and that day about three thousand persons were added.  
(Acts 2:1)

'As [people gather in that] public space [our prayer can be] that the same Holy Spirit would be poured out on us all that we will witness effectively to the God whose love changes the world.' (TKC)

### St. Faith's Church ROOF FUND

**THANK YOU** to those who have kindly responded to the appeal for funds to replace the Church roof following the theft of lead. The cost of replacement will be **£24,000**. We have reached the half way mark, **but still need to find £12,000**. Of course, we are still pursuing grant applications where possible.

**ROOF ALARM** - permission has now been granted for a roof alarm to be installed which is a requirement by the insurers where there is still lead on the roof. We are now able to go ahead with the installation, and have been awarded a grant of £2,000 from the Allchurches Trust towards the cost of nearly £4,000.
