Parish Council News (From the Parish Clerk 01788 891184)

The next meeting of Barby & Onley Parish Council will take place on **MONDAY 11th JUNE 2018 at 7.30pm** in **Onley** Village Hall, Onley Park, Willoughby, Rugby CV23 8AN. Members of the Parish are welcome to attend, and the first 20 minutes of the meeting will be open for Public Participation, so if you have a concern which you would like to make the Parish Councillors aware of, then come along and let them know about it. It may not be possible to provide an answer immediately, but the matter can be put on the Agenda for the following meeting. Meetings are held on the second Monday of each month at 7.30pm and usually finish by 9.30pm.

The Parish Council held their Annual meeting on 14th May at Barby Village Hall and we are pleased that David Blezard has been re-elected as Chairman of the Council for the coming year. Councillor Dawn Cotton is Vice-Chairman.

Cllr Lomax and Cllr O'Reilly were appointed as trustees of Onley Village Hall. Councillor Jones was appointed as Trustee to Barby Village Hall Committee. Councillor Blezard was appointed as representative to Tennis Court Management Group and ex-officio member of Barby Church Trust, Councillor Jones was appointed as representative to Barby Sports Field. (Please can those organisations make sure their representative Councillors are made aware of your meeting dates, so that they can come along, and give whatever help and support they can). Cllr Nigel Gove acts as the Internal Financial Controller and double checks all the accounts.

Vacancy for a Parish Councillor - Following the resignation of Councillor Howard Vale we still have a vacancy on the Parish Council. Dog Fouling – Please continue to clean up after your dogs, and DO NOT hang bags of dog poo on trees, even if you do mean to come back and collect it later. Remember that dogs are **not** allowed in the Allotments, Play Area, Sports field or Millennium Orchard. Thank you. **DO NOT take your Dog to the Village Fete on 23rd June, as they are not allowed in Barby Play Area.**
