Parish Council News (From the Parish Clerk 01788 891184)

The next meeting of Barby & Onley Parish Council will take place on **MONDAY 8th OCTOBER 2018 at 7.30pm** in Barby Village Hall, Kilsby Road, CV23 8TT. Members of the Parish are welcome to attend. The first 20 minutes of the meeting will be open for public participation, so if you have a concern which you would like to make the Parish Councillors aware of, then come along and let them know about it. It may not be possible to provide an answer immediately, but the matter can be put on the Agenda for the following meeting.

Welcome and Goodbye to Councillors - The Parish Council Chairman, Dave Blezard, has resigned as a Councillor as he is moving away from Barby. The Parish Council would like to say a huge thank you to him for all the time he has committed to the village. Dave was a driving force behind the Parish Neighbourhood Development plan and has been Chairman of the Council for the last three years. This leaves another vacant seat available. Please consider whether you would like to become a Parish Councillor and help decide how the Council tax is spent within the community. The Council is pleased to welcome James Wood from Onley Grounds House, Onley Grounds who joined as a Parish Councillor at the September meeting.

Parish Council Budget - The Parish Council is now starting to put together its budget for the year starting 1st April 2019. If any organisation within the village has a project which they would like the Parish Council to consider providing a grant towards, then please email details of the project, the costs and the money already secured to the parish clerk at clerk@barbyandonleyparishcouncil.co.uk. The Budget will be put together during October and published in draft form in November. The Councillors will agree the final form in December. It then has to be submitted to Daventry District Council in January so that they can calculate the level of rates to collect to meet the financial demands.

Speeding on Daventry Road, Barby – During a 39-hr period in September, 610 cars were registered doing speeds of over 30mph – this is 42% of all cars recorded. PLEASE REDUCE YOUR SPEED WHEN DRIVING THROUGH THE VILLAGE.

Barby Play Area - Broken glass has been found in the children's play area on more than one occasion. If anyone sees anybody with glass, please ask them to leave as if it gets broken it is very dangerous for any children playing on the equipment.

The Parish Council has purchased two "Lat Pull and Chest Press Combi" Adult fitness systems. One has been funded from a Tesco Bag grant and will be situated in Barby Play Area, and the other has been funded by a County Councillor grant to Onley Park and will be installed on the open space area. We are also waiting to see if we have been successful in securing an "Awards for All" grant to upgrade the equipment in Barby Play Area.

Onley - Street cleaning will take place at Onley to kill the weeds that build up along the edge of the kerb and then remove them. Weeds will also be sprayed on

the patio area of Onley Village Hall and along the path leading to the hall. Please be aware that weeds in the area will have been treated with spray.

There has been a recent spate of 4x4 tyre burglaries at Onley. Please be vigilant and report any suspicious activity and keep vehicles secured.

An orchard is to be planted at Onley Park on Sunday 7th October. There will be a fun day arranged to coincide with the planting. It is hoped that everyone will get involved and have a great time. Thanks to Grant and Samantha Haywood for their hard work in securing grants and getting this project off the ground.

Onley has been awarded a grant to cover 50% of the cost of a World War 1 commemorate bench. This is similar to the one at Barby situated near their war memorial. The WW1 bench for Onley will be positioned near the Parish Notice Board as you enter the estate.

Work is currently being carried out to trees at Onley Park following a tree survey carried out last year which identified works need to ensure that trees in the parish remain safe and healthy

Dog Fouling – Elkington Lane is becoming rather nasty with lots of dog poo left on the ground. This byway is used by lots of families, runners and dog lovers, so please clean up dog mess and put it in the bin. Thank You

Street Lights - Please report any faulty street lights to the Clerk Tel 01788 891184. If the light is at Onley, then please let Councillor Dawn Cotton know and she will report it.

Grit Bins - Northamptonshire County Council has decided that three of the village grit bins no longer meet their criteria and they plan to remove them. The bins are located outside "Arnold Arms", next to the bus shelter in Rectory Lane, and near the school. The Parish Council feel that it is important to have grit available at these points in the village, so are going to take over the grit bins and arrange for them to be filled. If they become low on grit once the frosty weather starts, please make the Parish Clerk aware so she can order some more grit. Grit can be spread from the bins by any member of the community but should only be used on footpaths and road junctions which everyone can use.
