

### **BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 2020 TO 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2021**

The Parish Council has put together its budget for the year starting 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021. The estimated spend for next year is £55,997. The Parish Council resolved to add an extra £1,333 to the reserve fund and raise a precept of £57,330 which represents a year on year increase of £4,000 to be collected via Council Tax. This represents a 7.5% increase and will mean an additional cost to Band D property households of £8.40 per year. Details of the draft Budget are shown on page 4 of this newsletter.

It has been very difficult to second guess how many extra costs and services the parish will have to provide as a result of the reorganisation of local councils following the demise of Northamptonshire County Council. We already know that we will have to take over the replenishment and spreading of salt from the grit bins near the School, Pub and Bus stop which the County Council are now longer maintaining.

As always, the Parish Council tries its best to secure grant funding for projects. A "Tesco Bags" grant and a grant from our County Councillor have been put towards funding outdoor fitness equipment at both Barby and Onley, and the extra cost was met by a grant from Daventry District Council. We have further grant money of £8,000 available which is being held by Daventry and will be released on a 50% match-funding basis, hence the need to add a little extra cash into the parish reserve fund. We have also included a sum towards any events which may be being planned to commemorate 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of VE Day from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020.

**CHRISTMAS 2019 WASTE AND RECYCLING ARRANGEMENTS** – Collections due on Christmas Day will instead take place on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> December and will cover food, recycling and waste. Similarly, collections due on New Year's Day will instead take place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> January (food and recycling only). Extra recycling will also be collected if you cannot fit it into your blue bin – please place items into clear or white bags next to your boxes (not black or green sacks). Don't forget that a range of festive items can be recycled, including foil-free Christmas cards and wrapping paper, sweet tins and drinks bottles. Garden waste collections (for those subscribed to the service) will take place on 11<sup>th</sup> December and then 8<sup>th</sup> January.

Christmas trees – Households can put their real Christmas trees in their garden waste bin or alternatively place them alongside their bins on 8<sup>th</sup> January.

**CLIMATE CHANGE CRISIS** – As a result of suggestions at the Climate Change meeting in October you will have noticed that this month's newsletter is now printed on 100% recycled paper. In addition, Barby Village Stores have a "Borrow a Bag" scheme of canvas bags. If you go to the shop without a bag and need one to get your shopping safely home, then borrow a bag and return it next time you are passing for someone else to use.

We have had a follow up meeting, and plan to plant more trees next year. We will also be arranging another village litter pick, and considering where we can plant more wild flowers to promote bees and insects and are also planning to arrange an Energy Event, to hear about ways to reduce energy bills and improve home insulation etc in the spring. We are holding a meeting of interested people who are prepared to put some of the ideas into practise. The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2020 at 7.30pm.
