Parish Council News (From the Parish Clerk 01788 891184)

The next meeting of Barby & Onley Parish Council will take place on **MONDAY 11th NOVEMBER at 7.30pm in ONLEY Village Hall**, Onley Park, Willoughby, Rugby CV23 8AW. The December Parish Council meeting will be held in Barby Village Hall on Monday 9th December when 2020/21 Budget will be finalised. Members of the Parish are welcome to attend, and the first 20 minutes of the meeting will be open for public participation. If you have a concern which you would like to make the parish councillors aware of, then come along and let them know about it. It may not be possible to provide an answer immediately, but the matter can be put on the agenda for the following meeting.

VACANCY FOR A COUNCILLOR - Following the resignation of Councillor Simi Pandhal, the Parish Council would like to thank Simi for her hard work on behalf of the parish, and particularly for working to get new equipment installed at Barby Play Area. Simi's resignation leaves a vacant seat on the Parish Council. If you are keen to take part in the decision on how the rates are spent within the parish, and can spare 2.5 hours per month to attend a meeting on the second Monday of the month, then please contact the parish clerk for an application form.

All parish and town councils in Northamptonshire, including Barby & Onley Parish Council, will have **elections on Thursday 7th May 2020**. These will coincide with elections to the shadow unitary councils and the election of the Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner. Due to Local Government Reorganisation, parish and town councillors are currently serving a five-year term of office. The next term will also be five years and then every four years, so that parish and town council elections and unitary council elections are aligned in the future (2020, 2025, 2029, 2033...)

PARISH COUNCIL BUDGET - The Parish Council is considering the budget for year commencing 1st April 2020 and deciding on the level of precept to set. Any organisation which hopes to request Parish Council funding in the coming financial year, needs to alert the Clerk as soon as possible. A grant procedure document is available on the website.
