Parish Council News (From the Parish Clerk 01788 891184)

Current Covid-19 advice – Please see the section on page 3 and try to stay safe and healthy and help prevent transmission of this virus.

Parish Council Meeting Cancelled - The Parish Council meeting which was to be held on 20th April 2020 is cancelled to ensure that we do not inadvertently put anyone at risk of infection from Coronavirus.

The Parish Council financial regulations allow the Clerk to arrange payments to deal with emergencies. The Clerk will arrange to pay suppliers, and will produce a “Parish Council Business Notice” on 8th April, which will be displayed on the village notice boards, on the website and circulated to all councillors, showing what is to be paid, and whether any planning applications require a response from the Council. Planning responses will be formulated by asking each councillor’s views by email. This is not best practise, but will allow business to continue. Any member of the public who wishes the Council to consider their views on a planning application, please email (clerk@barbyandonleyparishcouncil.co.uk) when you see it advertised on the “Parish Council Business Notice”, which will be displayed on the website and notice boards. Please also phone or email the Clerk if you think the councillors should be aware of any problems, and we will do our best to sort them out. All payments and business transacted in this way will be minuted and approved once we are able to meet safely again.

Annual Parish Meeting - The Parish Council has a legal requirement to hold an Annual Parish Meeting between 1st March and 1st June. This year this meeting was scheduled for 27th April. This meeting has also been cancelled.

Parish Council Elections - Thanks to everyone who was considering filling in nomination papers to stand as a councillor. – you now have another year to consider whether you would like to take on the role! The elections due to be held on 7th May 2020 have been postponed for a year, due to the Coronavirus outbreak, and so our current councillors will continue in their role for another 12 months.

Mowing - The grass verges in Barby are going to be cut by the Norse Group this year, but the play area will be continued to be cut by Steve Hartwell. Lamley Brothers are still cutting the grass at Onley. This will only take place when it is allowed.

New Councillor - Following the resignation of Councillor Jane Bubb, the Parish Council are pleased to welcome back Andy Sabine as a councillor. The Council would also like to take the opportunity to formally thank Jane for her time working on behalf of parishioners. We currently only have 10 councillors, so there is a spare seat which we will be able to fill once normal meetings resume. Anyone interested in spending a year as a councillor, please contact the Clerk.

Potholes - Although we will have less vehicles on the roads in the next few weeks, we do still have potholes, so please continue to report any that you come across. These can be reported on-line at www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/fixmystreet. If you would rather speak to a person then phone 0300 126 1000 between 8.00am and 6.00pm or 07000 782112 if it is an emergency outside these hours.

Play Areas – All the village play areas have now been shut and should not be used. This is because the Coronavirus can survive on metal and plastic surfaces for up to 72 hours, and none of us want to spread the virus. Obviously, please heed the latest guidelines given by the government

Defibrillator for Onley - The Parish Council has ordered a defibrillator for Onley Park, which will be installed in the red phone box located on the left-hand side as you enter the estate.

Should anyone suffer a heart attack, ring 999 and the emergency services operator will tell you what to do whilst an ambulance is on its way. They will ask you to send someone to get the defibrillator from the phone box whilst you stay with the patient and carry out cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The defibrillator is designed in such a way that it tells you clearly how to operate it correctly. You really cannot do it wrong, and it will not cause any harm, but it may just save a life, so do not be afraid to use it if necessary. As soon as possible we will arrange a training session on both CPR and the use of the defibrillator which we hope as many residents as possible will attend.

Repairs to Prison Drive, Onley - We have received confirmation that the prison access road has been surveyed and the issues quantified and Henderson & Taylor Ltd have been awarded the contract to carry out repairs. Whilst the works are ongoing, there will, out of necessity, be localised restrictions to traffic along the road (e.g. traffic light controlled local lane closures) but this will not be for very long and kept to a minimum. Work should start on 6th April and complete about 14th April – obviously this may be subject to change.

Trees for Onley - The Parish has been given 30 small whips (little trees) which will be planted around the estate. Gavin Callard is the man to contact if you would like to help plant them. Please remember to keep a safe distance from other people if you are out and about.

Coronavirus and what we can all do to help

Please continue to follow the Government advice to help stop coronavirus spreading:

✓ You should now only leave your home for one of the following reasons:

- Shopping for basic necessities
- Daily exercise
- Any medical need
- Travelling to and from essential work

✓ Everyone should follow the guidelines on social distancing. These include keeping a 2m space between individuals, avoiding non-essential use of public transport, working from home wherever possible. Gatherings of 2 or more people who do not live together is now prohibited. You must use telephone and online services wherever possible.

✓ If you do leave your home wash your hands as soon as you get home

Barby Village Stores - Are taking orders for people who are over 70 or have an underlying health problem that means that they are more at risk should they catch Coronavirus. Please, if you fall into this category, **stop going to the shop, or putting yourself into any situation where you are less than 2m from someone else.** Coronavirus can survive on metal and plastic surfaces for up to 72 hours so by touching the shop door handle for example, you are putting yourself at risk. All you need to do is ring Babs on 01788 890360 and he will tell you how to use the ordering system. Could **everyone** please distance themselves at the shop as to ignore this puts them and the shop staff at risk

If you really cannot avoid going out to a place where other people are likely to be, then wash your hands frequently, or use sanitizer gel.

The closures are necessary to ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of everyone and prevent further spread of the Covid-19 virus.
