Parish Council News (From the Parish Clerk 01788 891184)

Parish Council Meetings - Barby & Onley Parish Council Meeting will take place on Monday 12th October 2020 at 7.30pm. Due to the current Government restrictions to maintain social distancing to reduce the spread of Coronavirus Covid-19 the meeting will be held via a video conference using zoom rather than in the Village Hall.

and on the parish notice boards, 3 days prior to the meeting. Joining instructions to attend the zoom meeting will be published on the agenda, and members of the parish are welcome to attend. The first 20 minutes of the meeting will be open for public participation, so if you have a concern which you would like to make the parish councillors aware of, then please join the meeting and let them know about it. It may not be possible to provide an answer immediately, but the matter can be put on the agenda for the following meeting.

PARISH COUNCIL VACANCIES - Councillor James Wood has resigned his seat as a councillor as he is moving out of the parish. We now have two spare seats to fill. If anyone is interested in becoming a councillor, then please contact the clerk for an application form. The full council is up for election in May 2021, so this is a chance to try out the role for a few months. The term of office of our current parish councillors has been extended by a year due to the Covid-19 pandemic, which prevented elections taking place this May.

PARISH COUNCIL BUDGET - The Parish Council is now starting to put together its budget for the year starting 1 April 2021. If any organisation within the village has a project which they would like the Parish Council to consider providing a grant towards, then please email details of the project, the costs and the money already secured to the parish clerk at clerk@barbyandonleyparishcouncil.co.uk and a grant may be considered.

The budget will be put together during October and published in draft form in November. The councillors will agree the final form in December and then it will be submitted to Daventry District Council in January so that they can calculate the level of council tax to collect to meet the financial demands.

POTHOLEs - Please continue to report any potholes that you come across.

STREET LIGHTS - As the nights draw in, please report any faulty street lights to the clerk by email at clerk@barbyandonleyparishcouncil.co.uk. If the light is at Onley, then please let Councillor Dawn Cotton know and she will report it.

DON'T DROP LITTER - This time last year we were looking at ways to reduce single use plastic and to encourage people to take their litter home and do whatever they could to make the environment a better place. The impact of the Covid-19 virus shifted people's priorities, but the environment benefitted greatly from the lack of cars and planes, and litter reduced considerably.

Now that people are out and about more, please DO NOT DROP MASKS and GLOVES and continue to make a conscious effort to reuse and recycle. We will be arranging another village litter pick in the autumn and would love to see lots of volunteers coming to help clean up the verges.

WILDFLOWERS - Barby are planning to plant some areas of wildflowers in the spring. We hope the display will be as good as those planted in Kilsby. The wildflowers should help to encourage bees, butterflies and pollinators.

TREE WORK - The Parish Council has arranged for the dead cherry tree at the entrance to Rectory Close to be removed and the crown raised on the remaining one so that it is easier to walk under.

SPEEDWATCH - The initiative where we are able to borrow a speed gun over a 6 week period will not take place this year, as the police are unable to ensure that equipment can remain Covid-19 secure. Please try to drive slowly through the village and help remind other road users that it has a 30mph speed limit.

FOOTPATH MAP - The Parish Council used to have a footpath map on display in Lees Pit (at the junction of Daventry Road and Kilsby Road), which local ramblers could look at. It was taken down some time ago, and they are now considering whether it is valued enough to replace. If you would like to see the map replaced, or feel that it is unnecessary in this day of mobile data, then please email the clerk at clerk@barbyandonleyparishcouncil.co.uk or ring 01788 891184 to let us know. This will help the Council decide whether it is worth spending money on a new display board. Thanks.
