#### **Bus Consultation**

A short-term local bus policy is being developed by West Northants Council as part of a review of current provision. An interim bus policy will enable West Northants Council to maintain support for local bus services and the communities they serve until a new Local Transport Plan is developed and adopted. They are asking for views from people about the priorities they have identified to take forward into the interim policy.
